Greetings from our Founding Director

Dear well-wishers, we are a Non-Government Organization (S.5914/12593) based on sharing the love of Jesus by providing clean, safe and accessible water the needy Ugandan to communities, villages, schools and churches in order to empower, transform and sustain lives. Our goal is to drill 1,000 water wells/boreholes which will impact over 15 million rural lives.





We finished 2022 with a total of 29 water wells completed. A total of \$60,000 was invested in bringing clean water for 12 projects. We with started one water well/borehole in 2013 but as of now we have done 29 water wells. We have impacted over 40,100 +people. Many of these lives have seen the light, love and living water of Jesus through our work. We are praying for over 50+ new water wells for the year 2023 based on the high rate of needy villages, schools, churches and communities.

Lastly I want to thank all the people who stood with me when I lost my mum (Namutamba Scovia) on the 11th – Feb 2022. Thank you for all your support. We also thank Sue Henson who funded a water well to be made in memory of Scovia. We are glad the water well was completed June 2022. May God grant my Mum everlasting peace as she keeps resting with the angels in heaven.






